An Act to amend the West Bengal Cinemas (Regulation) Act, 1954.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the West Bengal Cinemas (Regulation) Act, 1954, for the purpose and in the manner hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted in the Forty-third Year of the Republic of India, by the Legislature of West Bengal, as follows:—

1. This Act may be called the West Bengal Cinemas (Regulation) (Amendment) Act, 1992. Short title.

2. In section 5 of the West Bengal Cinemas (Regulation) Act, 1954,— Amendment

(a) in sub-section (2), the words “and the terms and conditions laid down shall include the prescribing of such prices of admission as the licensing authority may determine” shall be omitted;

(b) after sub-section (3), the following sub-section shall be inserted:—

“(3A) The State Government may, from time to time, prescribe guidelines for fixation of prices of admission to places of public exhibition of cinematograph films and for classification of seats in such places by licensees, and it shall be obligatory for licensees to comply with such guidelines.”.
